



2007 PINOT NOIR

Rattlesnake Hills

VINEYARD NOTES: This is the second release of our Estate-grown Pinot Noir. The vines produced a very small crop of highly concentrated fruit. 2007 was a vintage year in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA with 2800 growing degree-days. This puts the AVA solidly in region II, just like the Napa Valley.
