



2010 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Rattlesnake Hills

VINEYARD NOTES: 2010 was a perfect growing year in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA. The Morrison Vineyard was planted in 1968 and is the oldest in the AVA. The old vines struggle to produce 2 tons to the acre. The grapes are extremely small and produce a wine with extravagant concentration of fruit flavors and tannins.

Cellar Notes: The wine was aged 2 years in new small French Tonnellerie d' Aquitaine oak barrels. This wine can be cellared for ten years. It will probably peak around 2015.

Tasting Notes: Big and fruity on the palate with integrated French Oak overtones and rich blackberry and black pepper notes on the nose.
