



2013 Petit Verdot Rattlesnake Hills

VINEYARD NOTES: This is Estate-grown Petit Verdot. The vines produced a very small crop of highly concentrated fruit. 2013 was a warm year in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA with cool nights allowing the grapes to retain great acidity.
